Acts 1:15-26 - January 18th, 2015 Message 2 of 8 in "Difference Makers: Time to Build"

**1 Corinthians 12:12-28** - "Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. <sup>13</sup>For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free - and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. <sup>14</sup>Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many...<sup>27</sup>Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."

Disciple Quick Facts

- Jesus individually called many disciples, while others joined in his public ministry as he began to have significant impact.
- Many people followed Jesus for a time, only to turn back when following Jesus took too much commitment. Matthew 8
- After spending an entire night in prayer, Jesus chose from his larger group of disciples 12 men, who would be the official representatives of him ministry. Luke 6:12-13
- The group of 12 disciples is listed 4 times in the New Testament. [Matthew 10/Mark 3/Luke 6/Acts 1 [minus Judas Iscariot])
- 70 Disciples who were following Jesus and working for Jesus were sent out to do ministry on his behalf "after" he had appointed 12.

Without an official role or title, and after having been passed over as a top-12 pick of Jesus, the unnamed disciples continued to follow Jesus, work for Jesus, and have \_\_\_\_\_6 for Jesus.
